Powerboat Magazine's "Runabout of the Year." The Formula 240 Bowrider earned top honors in 2006 for stunningly good design, exceptional build quality and stellar performance. Their speed test maxed out at 57.7 mph with the optional 496 MAG Mercruiser engine. The deep-V hull is based on a high-density, fiberglass-reinforced polyurethane structural matrix with foam-filled cavities for maximum structural integrity - no balsa core deterioration to worry about here. This freshwater 240 is in absolutely beautiful condition throughout with less than 140 hours on the meter. Canvas and upholstery are in excellent condition and the boat is exceptionally clean from stem to stern. The package includes a fiberglass dock box and a 2016 Load Rite tandem trailer with alloy wheels.
