Comments

Baja's 1996 240 Islander is a high-performance bowrider designed for comfort and heart-pounding speed. It's a great choice for day-cruising or water activities and with three-tone in-gel hull graphics, will turn more than few heads in the process. Coupling a big block MerCruiser engine with a solid deep-V hull creates a performance package that can handle challenging water conditions with both speed and comfort. This lightly used 240 Islander (less than 20-hours per year) has been professionally serviced every year, and comes with three colour-matched canvas systems that will keep her gelcoat and upholstery looking great for years to come. At less than \$20,000, we think it will be hard to find better overall bang for the buck in a comparable offering.
