Accommodations

Salon: Cherry woodwork, hardwood flooring (eucalyptus) port-side settee and navigation station with chart table, C-shaped dinette to starboard converts to berth, screened overhead hatch, dorade vent, fixed side windows, L-shaped galley, stereo system, bulkheadmounted TV, teak flooring.

Forward Stateroom: Double berth with storage below, custom sheet set, storage shelves, cedar-lined hanging lockers (2), overhead hatch with screen, cabin lighting, and privacy door.

Aft stateroom: Queen-size berth, padded headboard, cedar-lined hanging locker, screened hatch (opens to cockpit), opening port lights (2), cabin lighting, privacy door.

Galley: Corian countertop with backsplash, waste bin and stainless steel rail, dish rack cabinet with lighting and ventilation, double sink, built in microwave, 2-burner propane stove with oven, under counter fridge, separate front-opening freezer, storage cabinets above and below counter.

Cockpit: Dodger and bimini with full enclosure, port and starboard seating with seat cushions and drop-leaf table, pedestal helm with Lewmar folding wheel and single lever engine control, arch-mounted mainsheet traveler, rail-mounted BBQ, dedicated propane tank storage locker, smoked acrylic cabin access with screen, deep well lazarette.

Comments

The Hunter e36 (2011-2013) has an epoxy-coated solid fiberglass hull below the waterline and a Kevlar layer between stem and keel for added abrasion resistance. Topsides and deck are balsa cored. While designed with cruising in mind, the e36 is a very capable performer, especially in light winds. The e36 carries an impressive A/10 CE rating.

This original owner, freshwater, shoal-draft e36 is in exceptionally clean condition and loaded with Hunter's optional extra cost options and equipment. "Blown Aweigh" features include a space saving Lewmar folding wheel and a unique drop-down swim platform, both of which serve to open up the cockpit considerably. The non-skid deck has flush hatches and recessed handrails, which keeps your running rigging from catching on a raised hatch corner at the worst time. Hunter's trademark backstay-free rig and arch-mounted mainsheet traveler make for an uncluttered cockpit that is ideal for cruising.

All said and done, the e36 is a very comfortable, easy-to-handle boat that is affordable and still fun to sail.
